# ADMISSION NOTIFICATION (PROVISIONAL)

Heartiest congratulations to candidates who have been selected for taking admission to Maharashtra National Law University Mumbai.

Candidates who have been provisionally allotted MNLU Mumbai by the CLAT Office shall bring the enlisted documents [Annexure I] between the dates **28th to 30th June 2018** for completing the admission formalities at MNLU Mumbai for B.A.,LL.B(Hons.) and LL.M programs.

Candidates are advised to ensure that all eligibility conditions according to CLAT norms are fulfilled (<a href="http://information.clat.ac.in/eligibility.html">http://information.clat.ac.in/eligibility.html</a>). Those claiming admission under reserved or special categories should specifically ensure that they possess all necessary certificates and documents as are required under respective rules in original in support to their claim. It should be noted that onus of proof of eligibility to be admitted rests with the candidate and the University cannot relax or ignore any of the prescribed norms.

Verification of original documents prior to admission will be conducted between 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 at 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Conference Hall MNLU Mumbai between 09.30 am to 03.30 pm.

When candidate's documents are verified and found to be in order, then he/she will be required to pay the fees to complete the admission formality, as specified under:-
