

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

With the advancement in the field of Science and Technology, the scope and ambit of crime and the profile of Criminals have undergone rapid changes. The technology-based crimes spreading across the borders are posing a great challenge to the crime investigation machinery. The new generation crimes which include white-collar crimes, Cross-border crimes, cybercrime, etc must be approached in a purely scientific and technical manner for which the agencies including the police, prosecutors, judicial officers, and the defence lawyers are to be trained adequately.

With this objective Centre for Research in Criminal Justice, Maharashtra National Law University Mumbai offers the One-Year Advanced Postgraduate diploma in Crime Investigation, Medical Jurisprudence, and Forensics Science. The aim of the Program of Study is to bring together and provide guidance to, students interested in criminal justice, whether from advocacy, policymaking, or academic perspective (or some combination of perspectives). All students interested in this area, either in contemplation of an eventual career in criminal justice or as a subject of academic study, are encouraged to take a broad range of both lecture courses and seminars in criminal law and procedure as well as clinical offerings.

The proposed program will be of One-year duration spread over 2 semesters with 6 subjects, i.e. 3 subjects in each semester. Each course will be of 3 Credits which include classroom discussion, online lectures, practical exposure, field visit, and assignments. The program will be supplemented by Seminars, Workshops, Conferences, Special lectures from experts, etc. Each Course carries 100 marks with a 50% internal assessment component. The remaining 50% will be evaluated based on Examination and Project.



ELIGIBILITY

- a). The course is open to students (UG and PG), Research Scholars and Academicians and working professionals.
- b). Students enrolled in an undergraduate Law program who have passed the second year and are currently in the third, fourth, or fifth year of their course are eligible to apply.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Direct Admission is subject to fulfillment of the eligibility criteria for the said course and on the full payment of the fees.

DURATION

The course duration is of 1 year and the programme is to be completed within 3 years. Failing which re-registration on the term & conditions prescribed by the university is required. The course commences from May 2022. The course is divided into 2 Semesters. The first-semester exam will be conducted in December 2022 and the second-semester exam will be conducted in May 2023.

FEES STRUCTURE

Course fee:

Indian Students: Rs. 20,000/-Foreign Students: \$ 400 USD

The Convocation fee will be charged separately as per the University Rules. Re-peat exam fee / Supplementary Exam fee will be charged @ Rs.500/- per paper

Boarding & Lodging charges if any at the campus (subject to availability) during events/ exam will be extra as per the University Rules

COURSE STRUCTURE

The Post Graduate Diploma in Crime Investigation, Medical Jurisprudence and Forensic Science is a 20 credits programme consisting of 6 courses of 3 credits each and a project work of 2 credits.

CONDUCT OF THE PROGRAMME

The lectures for the Programme will be conducted in online mode which will be supplemented by 3 slots of classroom instruction of one-week duration each. Online lectures will be conducted only on the weekends and holidays. Every Lecture will be recorded. The recording of the lecture will be provided to the candidates only if prior intimation and permission will be taken from the course coordinator.

The learning environment includes online lectures on weekends, Webinars, Seminars, and conferences on Campus, practical demonstrations, visits to prisons, Juvenile Homes, Police stations, live demonstrations of various techniques used in various Forensic Science Institutions.
