Welcome Address: The Registrar, during his welcome address, emphasized that knowledge forms the foundation of all meaningful progress, both for individuals and institutions. Guest of Honor: Prof. Amar Pal Singh highlighted the power of knowledge and stressed that the foundation of a successful legal career lies in a fine balance between deep knowledge and practical skills. He stressed that while intellectual mastery of the law is crucial, it is the ability to apply legal principles with clarity, confidence, and empathy that defines a true legal professional. Importantly, he reminded students that a good lawyer must also be humble, as humility allows one to keep learning, respect diverse viewpoints, and serve justice with sincerity. He encouraged young scholars to cultivate analytical thinking, articulate expression, and ethical grounding in their professional journey.

Address by the Chief Guest: Justice Rajendra Menon drew from his four decades of experience in the judiciary and advised the students to be active and reflective listeners, as listening is foundational not just to advocacy but also to understanding justice. He encouraged young legal minds to look beyond traditional litigation and explore diverse and emerging career avenues like mediation, arbitration, policy-making, and judicial services. Highlighting the evolving legal landscape, he emphasized the growing relevance of alternative dispute resolution (ADR) in decongesting courts and delivering accessible justice. He also underlined the importance of professional ethics, clarity in communication, and emotional intelligence as essential tools for success in the legal world.


