Vacant Seats Admission Instruction

The allocation of vacant seats shall be done strictly according to the All India Rank (AIR) merit, for the above categories without any exceptions or deviations.

Please read the following instructions carefully to ensure a smooth application process.

A. MH-NTD Category (First Preference):

For admission to the **LL.M one year Programme 2026**, first preference shall be given to candidates belonging to the **MH-NTD** category, as the seat is reserved for the MH-NTD category. There is **no restriction on the All India Rank (AIR)** candidates applying under the MH-NTD category.

MH-NTB Category (Second Preference):

For admission to the **LL.M one year Programme 2026**, first preference shall be given to candidates belonging to the **MH-NTB** category, as the seat is reserved for the MH-NTB category. There is **no restriction on the All India Rank (AIR)** candidates applying under the MH-NTB category.

MH-NTC Category (Third Preference):

For admission to the **LL.M one year Programme 2026**, first preference shall be given to candidates belonging to the **MH-NTC** category, as the seat is reserved for the MH-NTC category. There is **no restriction on the All India Rank (AIR)** candidates applying under the MH-NTC category.

MH-DTA Category (Fourth Preference):

For admission to the **LL.M one year Programme 2026**, first preference shall be given to candidates belonging to the **MH-DTA** category, as the seat is reserved for the MH-DTA category. There is **no restriction on the All India Rank (AIR)** candidates applying under the MH-DTA category.

MH-ST Category (Fifth Preference):

For admission to the **LL.M one year Programme 2026**, first preference shall be given to candidates belonging to the **MH-ST** category, as the seat is reserved for the MH-ST category. There is **no restriction on the All India Rank (AIR)** candidates applying under the MH-ST category.



MH-UR Category (Sixth Preference):

For admission to the **LL.M one year Programme 2026**, first preference shall be given to candidates belonging to the **MH-UR** category, as the seat is reserved for the MH-UR category. There is **no restriction on the All India Rank (AIR)** candidates applying under the MH-UR category.

B. MH-SEBC Category (First Preference):

For admission to the **LL.M one year Programme 2026**, first preference shall be given to candidates belonging to the **MH-SEBC** category, as the seat is reserved for the MH-SEBC category. There is **no restriction on the All India Rank (AIR)** for candidates applying under the MH-SEBC category.

MH-OBC Category (Second Preference):

For admission to the **LL.M one year Programme 2026**, first preference shall be given to candidates belonging to the **MH-OBC** category, as the seat is reserved for the MH-OBC category. There is **no restriction on the All India Rank (AIR)** for candidates applying under the MH-OBC category.

MH-UR Category (Third Preference):

For admission to the **LL.M one year Programme 2026**, first preference shall be given to candidates belonging to the **MH-UR** category, as the seat is reserved for the MH-UR category. There is **no restriction on the All India Rank (AIR)** for candidates applying under the MH-UR category.

Waitlist Seats: If any of the seats mentioned above become vacant at a later stage, they will be allotted to candidates on the waiting list in accordance with the prescribed admission procedure. Subject to applicable rules and eligibility criteria.

INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES:

1. Application Form (**Annexure-A**) is available at [CLICK HERE](#) Application under any other mode will not be entertained. Candidates who have appeared for CLAT 2026 and are desirous of taking admission in **LL.M 2026 one year** at MNLU Mumbai under vacant categories should make an application in the above mentioned proforma (Annexure-A) expressing their interest in seeking admission for the academic year 2026-27.
2. Candidates must submit the prescribed **Google Form** within the stipulated deadline. Applications for which the Google Form is not submitted on or before the specified closing date and time shall be treated as **ineligible** and will not be considered for admission.

No requests for late submission, extension of the deadline, or any other exception shall be entertained under any circumstances.

Please note that applications submitted through email or any other mode will not be accepted. Only applications submitted through the prescribed Google Form will be considered.

- ix. Certificate of Disability (If Applicable) issued by Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India.
- x. Ex Servicemen/ Defense Personnel Certificate from the respective department Unit/ Dept. / HQ/ Records/ RSWO/ ZSWO/ Army/ Navy/ Air Force HQ
- xi. Application fees receipt.

PLEASE NOTE:- After filling out the Google form, you are requested to merge all the above-mentioned documents into a single PDF file and email the same to admission@mnlumumbai.edu.in for verification and further necessary action and subject to email document for **LL.M 2026 one year**.

4. Candidates are requested to pay prescribed fee of Rs. 1,000/- per application through PayTM towards application processing fees. (Once paid, the application fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances.)

5. Applications will be considered strictly based on CLAT 2026 All India merit rank (AIR) and fulfilling all the requirements as stated in this notification.
6. The University shall not be responsible for any electronic delay or default.
7. **Last date to apply is 06th September 2026, 11.59 PM.**
8. The result for vacant seat is tentatively scheduled to be published on 9th September 2026. However, the date may be revised depending upon the number of applications received and the time required for scrutiny and verification of applications and documents.
9. In case of withdrawal or cancellation of admission, the fee refund shall be processed in accordance with the **Fee Refund Policy 2026–27**. Candidates are advised to refer to the Fee Refund Policy available on the **MNLU Mumbai website** for detailed terms and conditions. The Fee Refund Policy shall also be applicable to candidates admitted against vacant seats.
10. Classes already started from 3rd of August 2026.
11. **PLEASE NOTE:** Kindly read the notification carefully and apply only if you fulfill the eligibility criteria.
