With Reference to the BAR COUNCIL OF INDIA (BCI) Circular no. D6161/2023 norm issued dated 20.10.2023. The fee refund policy is applicable for B.A. LL.B (Hons) 2026-31.

The last date of the admission is 28th July, 2026 for the Academic Year 2026-27.

Category	Percentage of Refund of fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the HEI	Date of the Refund
1.	100%	If the student files and application for withdrawal of admission 15 days before the last notified date of admission.	For withdrawal requests received before 13 th July 2026 100% University fee refund will be given.
2.	90%	If the student files an application for withdrawal of admission less than 15days before the last notified date of admission but within 30 days after it.	For withdrawal requests received between 14 th July 2026 to 27 th August 2026, a 90% refund will be given.
3.	80%	If the student files an application for withdrawal of admission between 31 and 60 days after the last notified date of admission.	For withdrawal requests received between 28 th August 2026 to 26 th September 2026, 80% refund will be given.
4.	00 %	If the student cancel the admission 61 days or more after the last notified date of admission.	No refund will be given for withdrawal requests received after 27 th September 2026, including cases where admission is granted against a vacant seat.

- In case of withdrawal or cancellation of admission, the request for refund must be sent to admission@mnlumumbai.edu.in, along with the duly filled and signed withdrawal form and all necessary supporting documents attached.

The date of cancellation/withdrawal mentioned on the withdrawal form shall be considered the official date for processing the request.

Please note that no interest shall be paid on the refund of fees under any circumstances. The refund will be initiated within 45 working days.

➤ **Hostel and Transportation Fees:**

- Hostel fees will not form part of the main academic fee structure. The hostel fees will be notified in due course
- The deadline for payment of Hostel and Transportation fees is **31st July 2026**.
- Hostel and Transportation fees for the semester shall be charged for the **entire semester**,
- Students who wish to cancel their Hostel and Transportation subscription on or before **31st August 2026** shall be eligible for a **100% refund**.
- No refund shall be paid for cancellations made **after 31st August 2026**, irrespective of the number of days attended.

➤ **IMPORTANT:**

Students joining after **31st August 2026** will be charged the **full Hostel and Transportation fees**.

➤ **Refundable Deposits:-**

Refundable deposits shall be returned in full, subject to submission of a No Dues Certificate duly cleared by the Academic Department, Hostel, Library, Administration, and Accounts sections.

- **Admission Processing Fee (Non-Refundable):** In the event of withdrawal of admission by a candidate, at any stage and for any reason whatsoever, an amount of **₹5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only)** shall be deducted as a **non-refundable Admission Processing Fee** from the University fee paid. The balance amount, if any, shall be refunded in accordance with the University's Fee Refund Policy.
- In case any required document is not available with the candidate, an **Undertaking in the prescribed format** must be uploaded along with the other documents.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Candidates are required to bring all original documents for verification. Candidates who fail to submit the required documents at the time of physical document verification their **admission will be cancelled**.
