NATURE OF SUBMISSIONS

The MNLU Mumbai Law Journal invites original, unpublished manuscripts from all academicians, authors, legal professionals, and Law students in the following categories:

I. LONG ARTICLES (3500-10000 WORDS, EXCLUDING FOOTNOTES)

Submissions in this category are expected to provide a comprehensive and rigorous engagement with the chosen theme and its existing literature. Authors are expected to demonstrate a mastery over the subject matter by navigating both established theories and contemporary developments.

II. ESSAYS/SHORT ARTICLES (1200-3500 WORDS, EXCLUDING FOOTNOTES)

Essays/short articles are more concise in scope and are focused on a particular issue and offer new perspectives and critical insights on the selected topic.

III. CASE STUDIES/COMMENT AND LEGISLATIVE COMMENTS (1200-3500 WORDS)

This category is meant for the analysis of any contemporary judicial pronouncement, legislative action, or policy proposal. Notes and Comments must trace the line of cases in which the decision appears and comment on its implications on the evolution of that branch of law.

IV. BOOK REVIEW (1000- 3000 WORDS)

In this category the authors are expected to write original, impartial, actual and specific book review on any book related with law and contemporary issues. It is expected from the author to maintain professionalism during making any comment on the book.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSIONS TO AUTHORS

- The submission of papers is open for Teachers/ Academicians/ Professionals/ Judges/ Jurists and Researchers. Only one co-author shall be allowed. Student can be the co-author.
- The author(s) should strictly follow the Bluebook 20th edition for a uniform system of citation.
- Headings should be according to the following standard:
 - § Headings: All Capitals & Bold Letters
 - § Sub-Headings: First letter Capital & Bold
- Submissions should be in Times New Roman, 12 font size with 1.5 line spacing, justified text and 1-inch margins on all sides of an A4 sheet besides the centre aligned page number at the bottom of each page.
- Footnotes should be in Times New Roman, 10 font size with 1.0 line spacing.
- Graphics, Charts, Tables, and Diagrams should be numbered consecutively and included in the body of the work.
- In case of references from websites, complete URL address, along with the last date of accessing the website should be mentioned.
- Submissions must be mailed to email id by the University only with the subject “Submission for Volume---, Type of Submission (Article/ Case Comment/ Book Review/ Law and Policy analysis)” along with a Covering letter addressed to Chief Editor, MNLU Mumbai Law Journal.
- The covering letter should include the author’s contact details, designation and institutional affiliation.
- Submitted entries must not have been sent for consideration at any other place for publication.
- All submissions will be scrutinized by the Review Committee and the shortlisted contributors shall be duly informed.
- All submissions shall meet the UGC anti-plagiarism requirement- only 10% content similarity.
- Mere submission of a manuscript shall not confer any claim for publication.
- The Editorial Board reserves all rights to take decision to publish the contribution or not.
- The Board’s decision as regards the interpretation of guidelines or any other matter related to the publication shall be final.
- The Editorial Board strives to review the manuscripts expeditiously and will convey the preliminary decision on your manuscript within 4 weeks of the date of submission.

COPYRIGHT

- Copyrights of all manuscripts are with MNLU Mumbai only.

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

- The manuscripts shall be submitted through this Google Form only. Submissions made through any other mode will not be entertained.
- Each author is allowed to submit a maximum of 1 manuscript, in .doc or .docx format.
- The author(s) shall submit the manuscript along with a duly signed Certificate of Originality and Copyright (in this format).
- Upon submission, the author(s) will receive a receipt of acknowledgement of submission along with a code for their manuscript. Kindly quote the same in any future communication.

WITHDRAWAL

- If the author(s) wish to withdraw their manuscript, they can send an email to journal@mnlumumbai.edu.in with the subject line “Withdrawal of Manuscript” on or before 30th June 2026.
- The final decision rests at the sole discretion of the Editorial Board.
