




MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD OF DEPARTMENT - (P.G.)






Dr. Karuna Akshay Malviya



IV. CENTRE FOR MEDIATION AND RESEARCH (CMR)

inaugurated in January 2019. It is the first Centre in India dedicated solely to the subject of Mediation. The Centre envisions itself as a place of Study and Research, and wishes to Collate, Build Resources, Archive and Disseminate the Knowledge, Process and Practice of Mediation and Conciliation in the Country.

The aim of the Centre is to design and run courses for the Study and Certification in Mediation, Conciliation, Conflict Resolution and Collaborative Dispute Resolution. The Centre also hopes to be able to publish papers/journals relating to Mediation, Conciliation, Collaborative Dispute Resolution and such practices.

CMR began its journey in January 2019, with an inaugural program on 19 January at the hands of the Hon'ble Mr. Justice A.S. Oka, who was then the Chairman of the Main Mediation Monitoring Committee of the High Court of Bombay.

After running a few workshops successfully in 2019, the Centre embarked on a journey of launching India's first MA Program in Mediation and Conflict Resolution. The Centre used the whole Covid 19 period of lockdown to design and launch the said 2-year degree course. Between Dec 2019 to Sept 2020, the Centre engaged with various faculty, worked and reworked on modules, syllabi, modus of teaching, pedagogies of different faculties, budgets, resources, documentation and content development, and finally publicising and marketing the program. Sometime in June 2020, the Centre engaged a full time Co-Ordinator for the launch of the unique degree program.

MNLU received more than 40 applications for the degree program. It successfully began in Sept 2020, fully online.

Now that the program is on track, the Centre will begin its regular activities of programs and workshops in 2021. The Centre has planned 2 series of programs called 'Meet a Mediator' series, and 'Moderate a Dialogue' series, to be continued in 2021. These series will be for general public, and will begin in March 2021. It may be recalled that one program each on both these series was conducted in Dec 2019 and Jan 2020. The Centre has also planned the following paid workshops to be conducted in the year 2021:

The Centre for Advanced Training in Taxation laws is established at Maharashtra National Law University, Mumbai with the objective to advance Studies and Research in the area of Taxation.

The Centre has the vision to foster and promote a thorough understanding of the Indian Tax System, tax policies and laws and their implication for domestic and International Business Practices.
